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
## SUMMER PICNIC

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
## CHASING SUNSETS

Every sunset has its own unique character. Seasoned sunset chasers have mastered the art of predicting dramatic sunsets by simply observing cloud cover, air quality, humidity, and wind.

As Paulo Coelho writes, "Beautiful sunsets need cloudy skies." Wispy, whimsical cirrus clouds that sit high in the sky reflect long-wave colours, and create the perfect canvas for the late afternoon play of light. That light, in all its vivid colours, scatters wonderfully when the air is pure. Over open sea in the tropics or after a storm, sunsets are especially photogenic because rainfall cleanses the atmosphere. Similarly, the amount of moisture in the air plays a role in determining the sundown colour story, with hues more vibrant in low humidity. The final hand belongs to the wind, as clouds and air particles are at the mercy of the breeze.

During the summer months in Amanpulo, these elements connive to indulge sunset chasers with stunning visions of colour and light, worthy of a celebratory toast as the sun melts into the sea.



# COVID-19 UPDATE



Amanpulo is certified compliant with the Aman Covid-19 Safety Assessment in partnership with SGS, and is pleased to earn the Sharecare VERIFIED™ with Forbes Travel Guide verification that covers over 360 global health security standards.

Filipino citizens and select foreign nationals with valid and existing visas may enter the Philippines effective until 21 April 2021. A heightened Enhanced Community Quarantine is in effect over Metro Manila and four provinces until 11 April 2021. Palawan remains categorised under a more relaxed Modified General Community Quarantine, which allows Amanpulo to continue its operations. Amanpulo is accessible to guests via flights from the Subic International Airport and Cebu International Airport.
